TIME TO NARROW YOUR COLLEGE SEARCH AND BEGIN THE APPLICATION PROCESS

It is time to begin narrowing your college search and completing the application process for those colleges and universities you are considering attending next year. Every college has its own deadline system and usually there are many hoops to jump through before the process is finalized. Those who apply early receive more scholarship and financial aid information simply because colleges don't process scholarship applications until admissions applications are accepted. By contacting and researching your top college/university choices now, you will become familiar with not only the application process but the deadlines as well.

To apply for admission:

1. Submit paper application or apply online (online applications are processed quicker)
2. Pay the application fee
3. Request that a transcript is sent from NCHS

Wal Mart:

- Be a current high school senior
- Be admitted to KSU

Creative and Performing Arts Scholarships: One time, non-renewable award of approximately \$3,000. Must have a 3.0GPA, rank in the top 20% of your class, have and ACT composite score of 22 or higher. **DEADLINES:** Apply for admission to KU by December 1, 2006. You must be admitted to the School of Fine Arts and Design by January 10, 2007. If you qualify you will be asked to submit the following; One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, 10-20 slides of two and three dimensional art work, and a one page essay outlining education plans and career goals.

February 1-Deadline for general scholarships

Do you have a 3.5 GPA and an ACT composite of 28? If so, you might consider applying to the PSU Honors College. Applications can be downloaded at www.pittstate.edu/admin/vpaa/honorscollege.html.

DEADLINE: February 1, 2007.

Honors College-Presidential Scholars must maintain a 3.4 GPA in course work taken at PSU. These scholars typically had a composite ACT of more than 30 and a high school GPA of 3.9. Twelve students will receive an academic scholarship which includes tuition and fees, a book stipend, and room and board.
