## **Memorial Scholarship**

These scholarship awards are in memory of the late Maxine Marsh. Maxine was a life long resident of Norton County and had a wish to help students continue their education.

These scholarships will be awarded annually. The annual interest money earned from the initial investment principal will be divided among the recipients selected by the trustees. The dollar amount of the scholarships will depend on the annual investment rates, and the number of applications received.

### **Guideline for Application and Recipients:**

1. Applicant must be a Norton High School graduate and possess no less than a 2.5 grade point average. High School seniors and past graduates are eligible.
2. Applications, appropriate transcripts and resume will be due in the NCHS School Counselor office or to Mr. Robert D. Wyatt by April 15<sup>th</sup> each year. Scholarships will be announced during the High School awards presentation.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need, academic and citizenship. Selection will include those students planning to attend vocational technical schools.
4. Awards will be distributed at the beginning of each semester. Awards will be paid directly to the recipient's institution to help cover tuition, fees, etc., upon proof of enrollment. Student must provide institution mailing information.
5. Applicant's must maintain a C average and provide official post secondary transcripts to receive the second half of an award. Post secondary transcripts should be sent to Mr. Robert D. Wyatt for second payment.
6. A committee consisting of the Estates Trustee's will evaluate applications and make the awards.
